- RAIN OR SHINE
- Teams consist of 4 members but you may bring a 5th member as an alternate. The alternate, if not teamed up, will still compete for an individual score.
- Shooters may use any semi-auto or bolt action US military rifle, or a reproduction of any semi-auto or bolt action US military rifle, utilizing open, or iron sights only.
- No optics allowed. No full auto rifles allowed.
- Shooters need to supply 12 rounds of ammo for score. They should also bring more rounds to use during the practice evolution. 30 total rounds suggested.
- Shooters will be issued 3 targets and as such will have a practice evolution to fire as many rounds and they want in 10 minutes sitting from 50 yards. For score they will have 20 minutes to fire 10 rounds sitting from 50 yards, and they will have 5 minutes to fire 2 rounds standing from 25 yards.
- Shooters, RSOs, and tabulators do not have to be a Veteran to participate.
- No part of the rifle may rest on the bench while shooting.
- Spotting scopes are allowed ONLY during the practice round.
- No spotting/helping shooters while shooting for score.
- The winning team will take home the traveling trophy, and is required to return it the following year.
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place individual shooters will each receive a trophy and \$15 cash.
- ONLY ONE WARNING WILL BE GIVEN FOR RANGE RULES VIOLATION.
- SECOND VIOLATION WILL BE A DISQUALIFICATION.
- REPORT ANY UNSAFE CONDITION TO A RANGE OFFICER.
- Proceeds will go to the Mexico, Missouri Veterans Home

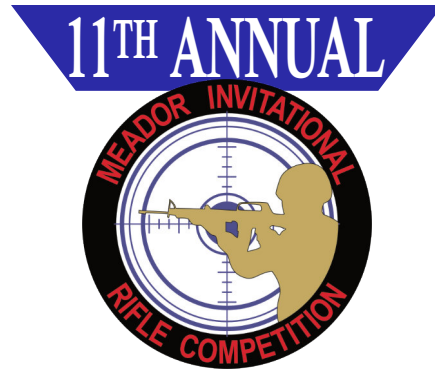
